**Kennys** are pleased to offer, in conjunction with Kelyousha Company Ltd, Digital Publishers, Tokyo, a collection of **25,000 photographs** from the Kyodo News Archive, reproduced in high quality CD ROM.

The collection includes many historically important photographs relating to the **Major Wars and Conflicts** of the 20th Century. Of particular graphic importance are the items relating to The Korean, Spanish and Second World Wars, to footage from The Korean War in 1950.

The photographs range from the Japanese invasion of Manchuria in 1931 triggering the long Sino-Japanese War of the 30's and 40's, through images of the Second World War fought on both the European and Pacific fronts, to footage from The Korean War in 1950.

The **research and academic value** of the collection is significant. The collection of images from the Pacific War in particular is, as far as we are aware, the largest in existence.

All **captions** are fully searchable. Each image is presented with a text description that includes date, place and other relevant details. In some cases, original typescripts from news correspondents are also included.

Photographers whose work is featured include Robert Capa, W Eugene Smith and Carl Mydans.

**Additional "local" information** such as news agency stamps, have also been scanned.

All articles are in Text format for easy free-world searches.

**About MrSID**

The image files of this CD-ROM are compressed with the technology of Multi resolution Seamless Image Database (MrSID). Unlike other compression technologies such as jpeg, which offers approximately a 4:1 compression ratio, image quality with MrSID software is in no way impaired or distorted.

Compression occurs at a ratio of almost 30:1. MrSID can take an 80 megabyte, high resolution image and shrink it by 97 percent to a 2.4-MegaByte reproduction-quality, single source image. All photographs are scanned in 600 dpi.

The most important feature of this product is that it allows one to view all the photographs and articles in an effective and impressive way. For example, it is possible to divide the screen into two parts, enabling one to view both the photograph and the text on the back of it simultaneously.

All photographs and text can be easily manipulated: either enlarged or reduced. You may choose to either view or hide the text. It is possible to view the smallest detail of a photograph by zooming in on it without compromising the quality of the image.

The photographs in this collection are of significant interest not only to historians, museums and libraries but also to researchers, filmmakers and publishers.

The first title in the series "The Spanish Civil War" will be available June 2002.
