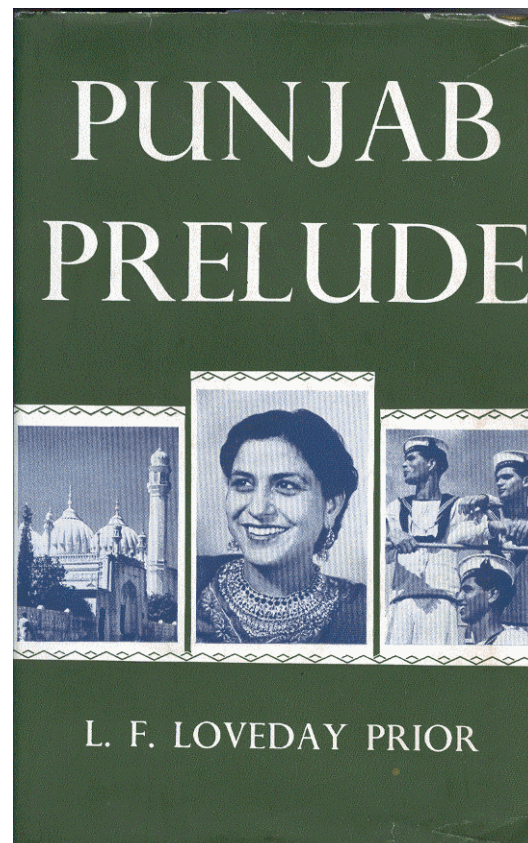

Introduction

Kashmir, a mountaineous area North of India and West of Tibet has been a source of disagreement between India and Pakistan since the division of the subcontinent in 1947. Despite an almost three-quarters Muslim majority, Kashmir's Maharaja (ruling prince) elected to join Hindu dominated India.

India has since argued that this decision and subsequent elections in Kashmir have made the province an integral part of India. Pakistan has asserted Kashmir's right to self-determination in accordance with a U.N. resolution.

The dispute triggered open warfare between the two countries in 1947-1948 and in 1965. Tensions in the region have been reinforced now that India and Pakistan are both nuclear States.

This collection offers much immediate and locally published material and pamphlets that throw light on the divergent politics of the two nations and the role of Kashmir.
