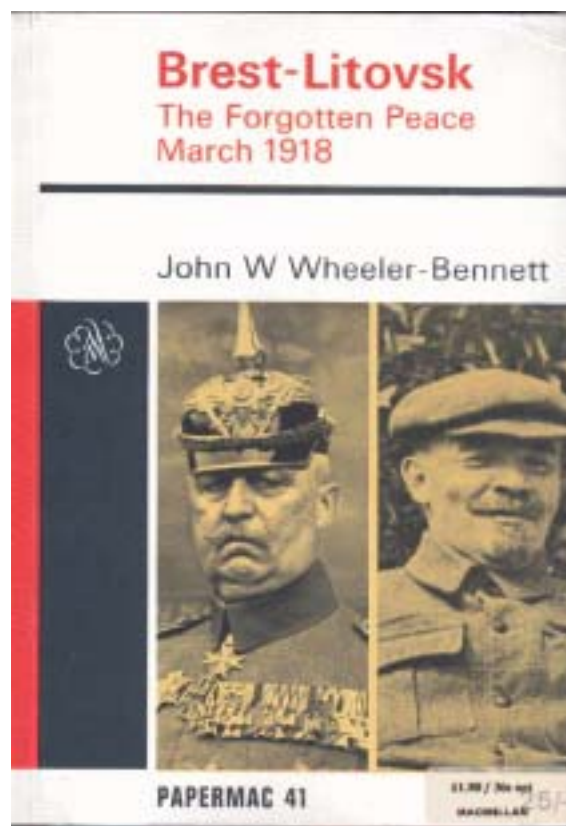

## Introduction

Known universally as the “war to end all wars”, the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand in Sarajevo precipitated a European mechanised conflagration whose scale and cost in human life was hitherto unknown in world history.

This collection explores the causes, nature and socio-political effects of World War I. The material examines the way the war was fought, the social impact of the new technology, why men went to battle and why the world which they found after it ended was totally transformed.

Attention is also given to the complex events that led directly to the outbreak of war and incorporates the sometimes conflicting historical interpretations of the period – the international system, the arms race, international economic factors, imperial rivalries etc...
