Introduction

Monographs offering historical analysis and a wealth of critical opinion on the lead up to and the military machinations of the twentieth century's global conflicts are many. Much more difficult to locate, however, are the pamphlets and ephemeral material from the time.

Collected here are prime examples in surprisingly good condition. Categories covered are numerous, e.g. items relating to military and civil transport are presented alongside examinations of women's roles in the way.

The German perspective is reasonably well represented with a good smattering of texts published in Germany between 1925 and 1950.

Of interest too are The Catholic Truth Society publications that throw light on the Church's involvement in the political turmoil of those early decades of the 20th century; an involvement whose details are only very slowly becoming revealed.
