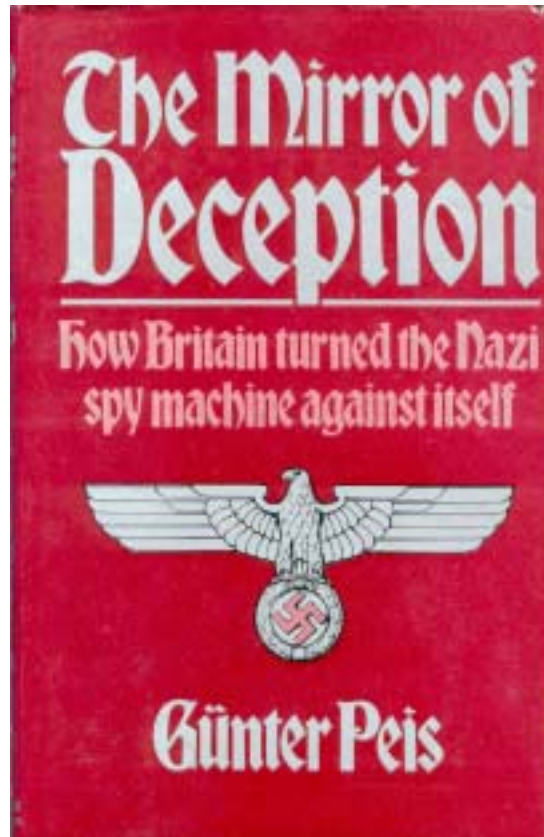

Introduction

This collection provides detailed & comprehensive information on all aspects of the so-called 'Secret War' – subversive operations waged by clandestine, subversive and heroic figures behind the scenes of the Second World War. During that period, resistance movements grew up in some thirteen enemy-occupied countries of Europe and South-East Asia, contributing in varying degrees to the success of Allied operations. The task of organisations such as the Special Operations Executive (S.O.E.) was to participate and support all these underground organisations and activities – in the words of Winston Churchill 'to set Europe ablaze'.

This material examines and illuminates this process providing an insight not only into the political machinations of governments, but also into the operatives and individual operations of this most secret of wars.
