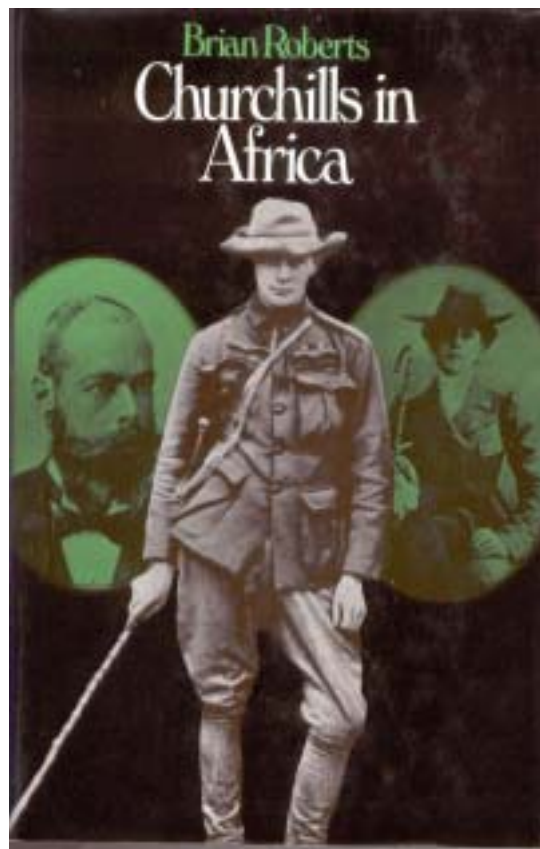

Introduction

Churchill's political reputation, his stature as a foreign affairs strategist has been more than adequately analysed. Hagiographic bibliographies seemed to be published almost on a weekly basis following the successful defence of Britain and subsequent political events in World War 2.
