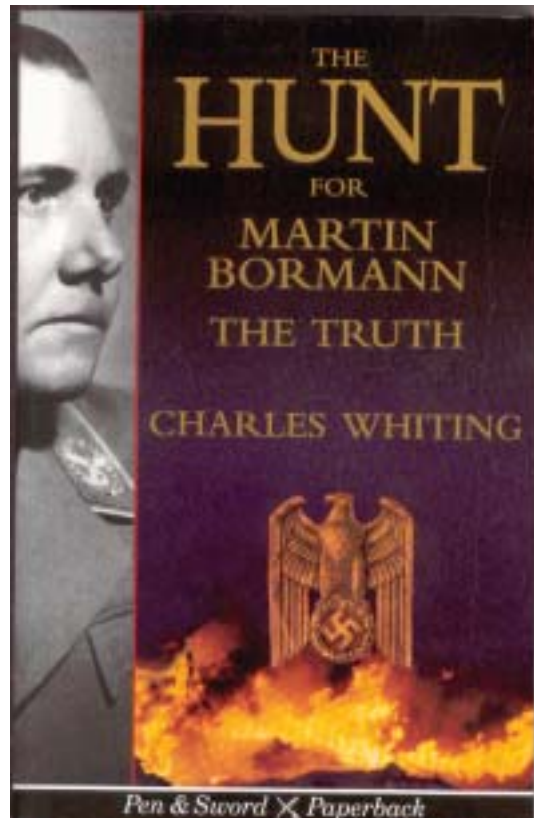

Introduction

Over 50 years after the event, the Nuremberg trials remain the most important (and controversial) International Legal assault ever launched against aggression and atrocities.

This collection focuses on the machinations of how the Allies finally agreed to try the surviving twenty two Nazi leaders under International Law.

The Collection provides a theoretical background on the culpability of military leaders, particularly relevant in light of a recent focus on the Yugoslav crisis and so called “ethnic cleansing”.
