

Introduction

Condemned as a from of racism and racial discrimination in 1975 by the United Nations General Assembly, modern Zionism (the establishment in Palestine of a Jewish homeland with its capital at Jerusalem) dates back from 1896 when Theodor Herzl published his scheme for an autonomous Jewish commonwealth, in response to European anti-Semitism, in his Jewish State.

This selection of texts traces the subsequent history of the movement through the formation of the World Zionist Congress to the division of Palestine in 1947 and beyond.

Topic covered include:

- The Balfour Declaration
- The British Mandate In Palestine
- The Jews In The Post War World
- 'Illegal' Settlement In Palestine
- Arab/Jewish Tensions In The Middle East

There are also noted publications by Norman Bentwich; Israel Cohen, Theodor Herzl's <u>Diaries</u> published by Victor Gollancz, and <u>The Jewish State</u>; and Autobiographies of Nahum Goldmann & Chiam Weizmann.

The collection also includes an authoritative bibliographical guide to Anglo-Jewish History, compiled by Cecil Roth.
