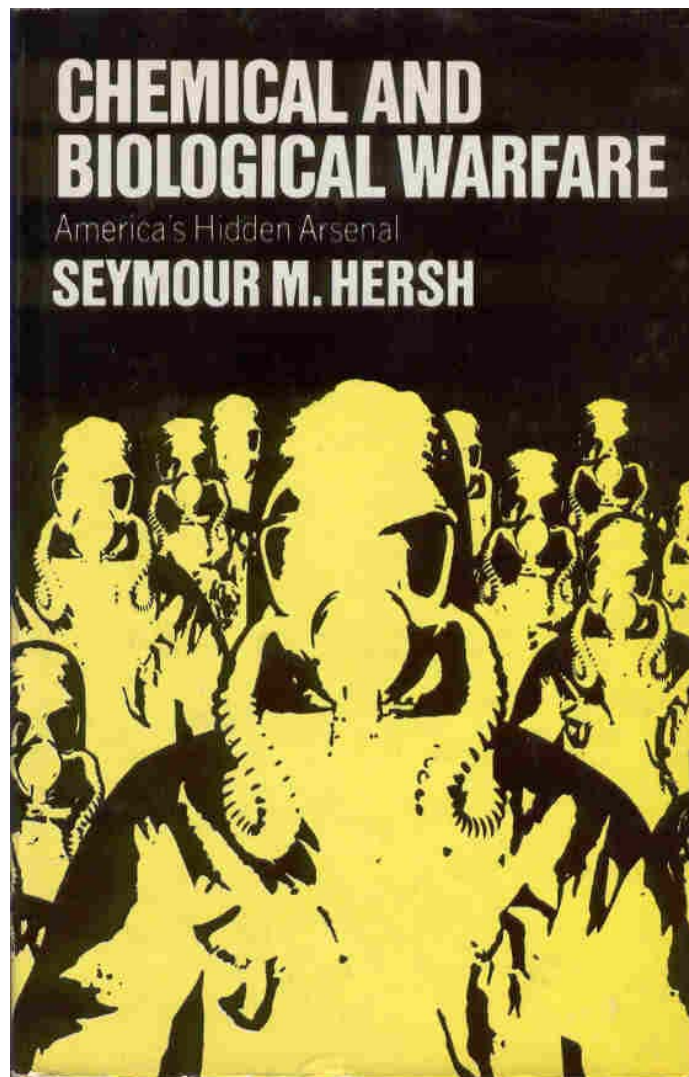

Introduction

Since the late 1960's, terrorism has increasingly become a substitute for popular struggle. Its aims: blackmailing the state and capturing media attention with spectacular acts of violence.

This collection on the phenomenon of twentieth century terrorism answers many questions. How are terrorist groups organized? What is their social base? What are their strategies – and what strategies can be employed against them? The material draws on a wealth of examples, from the Red Brigades and the IRA to the Mujahidin and E.T.A.

The collection throws light on some of the most central & controversial political issues of modern times.
