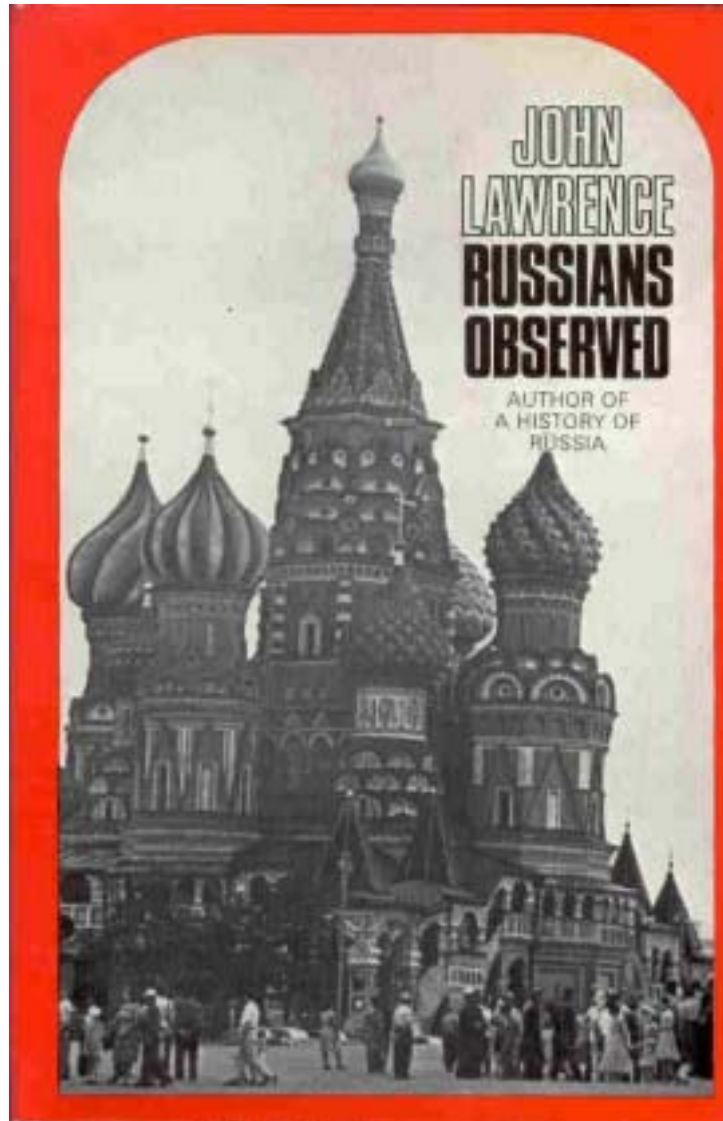

## Introduction
